SLOVAK JUNIOR OPEN 2016

EUROPEAN JUNIOR CIRCUIT 2016/2017

The event complies with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com. All participating MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) and aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

DATES

Friday, 23 September - Sunday, 25 September 2016 The tournament will commence Friday 9.30 AM at the earliest.

Players may only enter **one** category. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches. All matches will be played as the best of five games.

PRIZES

Players finishing in medal positions will receive diplomas, trophies and valuable presents.

ELIGIBILITY

Slovak Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 13, 15, 17 or 19 on Sunday, 25th September, as appropriate (Rule B7a).

SEEDING

The tournament will be seeded by ESF in conjunction with the tournament organisers according to the ESF Junior Ranking valid at the closing date. Tournament results will be updated regularly on the tournament website.

MATCHES

All matches will be played under the rules of the WSF. PAR 11 scoring to 2 clear points will be used. The recording of matches for coaching / performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and / or their parents / coaches do not object

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

BALL

The Dunlop Pro ball will be used.

EYE GUARDS

All junior players (under 19 years of age) must wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play. The list of WSF Certified Eyewear allowable at the time of participation can be viewed on the WSF website.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance.

PENALTIES

E4. a) If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office no later than two days after the final day of the tournament (email: esf@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1424 774879). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

- b) If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.
 - If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
- c) If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the final day of the tournament. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

CANCELLATIONS

For withdrawals/cancellations between 5th September and 16th September inclusive, 50% of the package fee (less any bank charges) is refundable.

TRANSPORT

All players arriving by plane at Bratislava airport will be picked up from and driven back to the airport free of charge.

All players arriving by plane at Vienna airport (50kms) can use regularly bus from Viena Airport to Bratislava and will be picked up from bus station free of charge.

Bus or van transport to the hotel will be provided for any group of players arriving at Bratislava airport or train station. The requests for pick-up must be communicated with tournament office. A shuttle bus will run between the squash centre and the hotel for the duration of the tournament. A timetable will be displayed at the centre.
